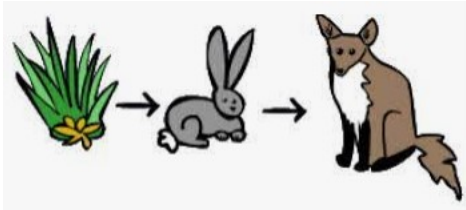
Living Things and their Habitats (Classification)
